### Program

**John Poyzer** presented an update on the *Storm Water Project*. There have been 6 Town-hall Meetings in July to discuss this issue. The project encompasses the entire region. 2/3rds of the region involves Colorado Springs with the rest of the area includes Fountain, Manitou Springs, and Falcon. Monument and Palmer Lake have not committed as of yet.

Storm water is defined as that water which runs off from rain and snow melt. It also includes water running off of roofs, pavement, or any other impervious material.

In 2006, the storm water system was given the grade of D- for our region. The neglect in this realm has led to destruction of our bridges and roads. This has been going on for 20 to 30 years.

If enacted, there could be 350 jobs/year generated to fix our problems.
